Who you thought was cool



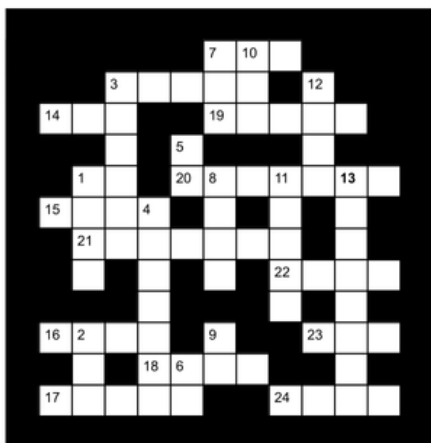

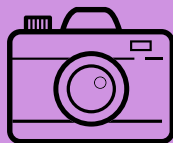

Let no man () — — you so low as to hate him.

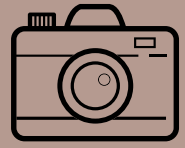
Our lives begin to end the day we become () — — — — about things that matter.

There comes a time when one must take a position that is neither safe, nor politic, nor popular, but he must take it because conscience tells him it is () — — —.

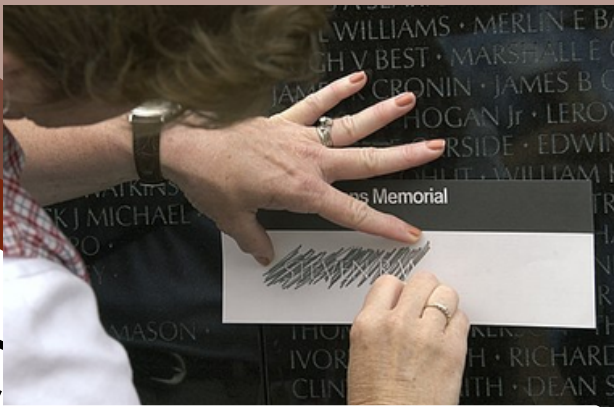
Forgiveness is not an () — — — — — — — — — — act, it is a constant attitude.
